REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.2, Carbine Resources Limited ("**Carbine**" or "**the Company**") the Company requests a voluntary suspension of its securities from the commencement of trading on Thursday, 25 May 2023.

The Company provides the following information regarding this request:

1. The reason for the voluntary suspension is for the Company to consider a potential legal claim from a major shareholder and the royalty holders with respect to the Muchea Silica Sand Project.
2. The Company requests that the suspension remain in place until the earlier of the commencement of normal trading on Thursday, 1 June 2023, or until the release of an ASX announcement regarding the potential claim.
3. The event that will end the voluntary suspension is the announcement referred to in paragraph 2.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
